Supplier Charter

Environmental policy and standards

The supplier must familiarize itself with the QSE policy of Solcera (see *the verso*). The supplier is responsible for compliance to domestic regulations of the various European Union member states transposing European environmental regulations. The supplier must satisfy the QSE requirements integral to any order placed by Solcera.

Personnel training

The supplier must provide for its own personnel, all necessary training to acquire skills required for the performance of any task which may have an environmental impact or generate a risk to people. Solcera reserves the right to request documentary proof of such skills (qualifications or certificates).

Use of dangerous substances

The supplier shall verify the compliance of his products to the REACH directive and notify Solcera of any sales limitation due to this Directive.

The supplier shall use and solely deliver products free of any dangerous substances listed in the RoHS directive. The supplier undertakes liability and responsibility to notify Solcera of all products entering Solcera's site which fail to comply with this directive.

Best technology available

The supplier will use the best technology available for each environmentally sensitive industrial process.

Packaging

The supplier will implement any improvements to reduce the quantity of packaging used and incorporate recyclable materials whenever possible. The use of expanded polystyrene wedges or pellets for deliveries to Solcera is prohibited.

Presence on site

The supplier will comply with all work procedures on site (Registering at the entrance is mandatory, compliance with prevention plans, safety protocols, and disposal of waste).

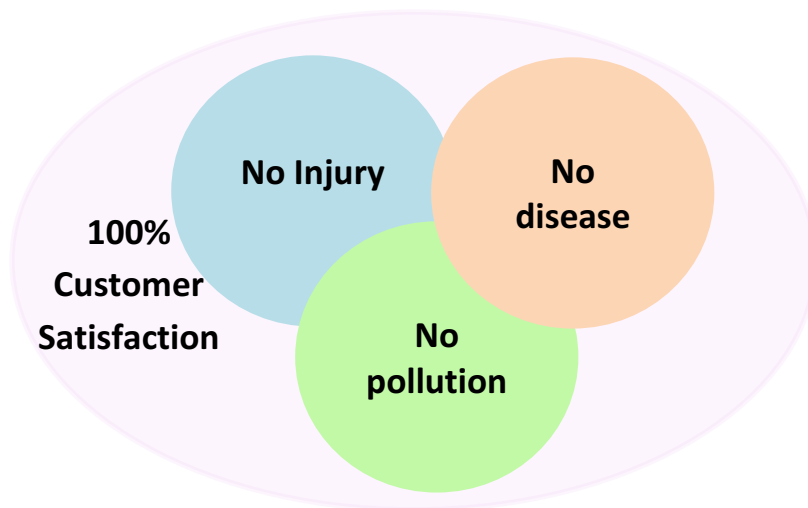
QSE Policy
